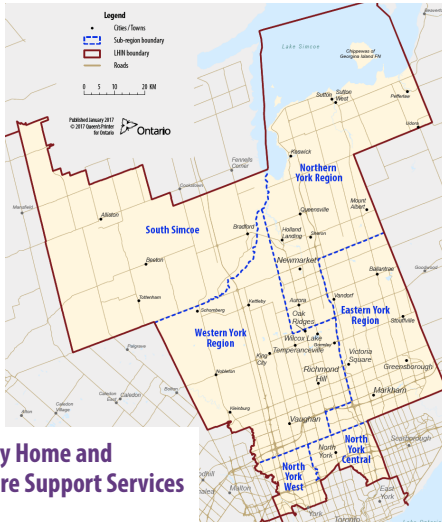


About Home and Community Care Support Services Central
